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1.1 Schools within The Mead Educational Trust (TMET) are committed to supporting children and young people with medical needs and recognise that significant ill health or medical issues can negatively impact on educational progress. TMET believes that all children and young people should be supported through illness to minimise the risk of disruption to their education.

1.2 We aim to ensure that all children who are unable to attend school due to medical needs continue to have access to as much education as their medical condition allows to enable them to reach their full potential. Due to the nature of their health needs, some children may be admitted to hospital or placed in alternative forms of educational provision. We recognise that, whenever possible, pupils should receive education within their school and the aim of such provision will be to reintegrate pupils back into school as soon as they are well enough. We understand that we have a continuing role in a pupil's education whilst they are not at school and will work alongside parents/carers, the Local Authority and other partners to ensure that children with medical needs receive care and support.
